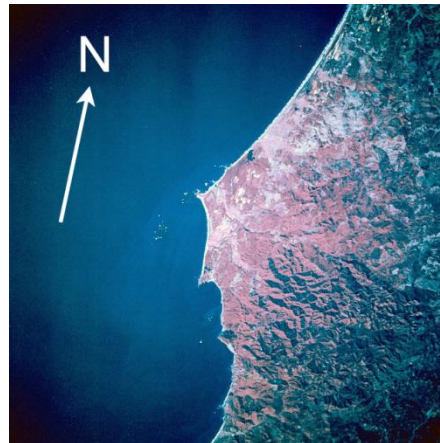
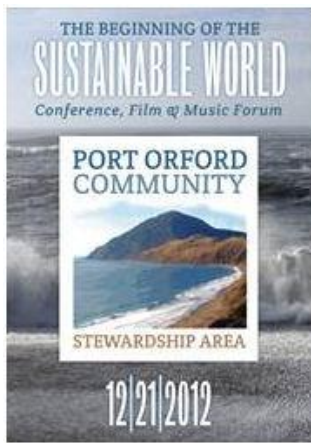
Ecosystem Based Management Comes to Southern Oregon Port
